CAT Air Dryer Cartridge Installation Instructions

WARNING: Read, understand, and follow safety precautions/instructions and to all safety labels

attached to drying system. Failure to do so may result in serious injury, death, and/or

Note: *steps marked in green are to be conducted by the customer.

SAFETY WARNINGS:

1. Read entire instructions before installation or servicing of the air dryer.

- 2. Never connect or disconnect any hoses/lines containing air pressure or remove a component, fitting or pipe plug unless you are certain that all system air pressure has been completely de-pressurized.
- 3. Never attempt to service an air dryer until you have read and understood all recommended procedures.
- 4. Use only proper tools and observe all precautions pertaining to the use of those tools.

INSTALLATION of New DESICCANT CARTRIDGE KIT (Recommend replacement every 1-2 year service interval) = Part #619003

- 1. With dryer base assembly securely mounted to air compressor's tank, use strap wrench to remove old desiccant cartridge, flat gasket, 3-micron pre-filter pad, & O-ring on cartridge stud from dryer assembly:
 - a. Install new O-ring around the threaded cartridge stud on top of the air dryer base assembly.
 - b. Place new white 3-micron pre-filter pad around newly installed O-ring. Carefully apply small amount of lubricant to both new O-ring & threads on cartridge stud in order to ensure easy removal of cartridge in the future. This is an <u>oil-free</u> compressed air system...so please be sure to remove any excess grease that may have been incidentally been applied to other surfaces.
 - c. Insert black flat gasket into bottom of new cartridge base plate and carefully apply thin layer of lubricant only to the surface of the black flat gasket.
 - d. Assemble new cartridge onto threaded cartridge stud while being careful NOT to cross-thread. CAUTION: If X-threading should occur, inspect all threads for integrity. DO NOT use dryer base if the threads on cartridge or threaded cartridge stud appear visually damaged in any way.
 - e. Hand tighten cartridge clockwise until the black flat gasket makes contact with the dryer base.

 After gasket makes contacts with base, continue turning cartridge for approx. 1/4 of an additional lockwise turn. **NEVER** attempt to employ use of a strap wrench to tighten new cartridges onto the dryer base.
 - f. Re-pressurize the compressor and air dryer to listen for presence of any compressed air leakage and tighten cartridge clockwise (if deemed necessary).
 - g. REMINDER: Do not over-tighten cartridge as future removal of cartridge may be very difficult.
